Winemaking

There are several unique vineyard sites throughout the Paso Robles wine growing region. For an area so large this is to be expected. What is a bit more surprising is how diverse and unique sites can be in much smaller segments of much closer proximity. Other than Spanish Springs, which we use for our Lagom Chardonnay, Moonsprings Vineyard is the furthest distance from our estate at just over six miles as the crow flies. From my kitchen window on the top of our property, we look directly across the Willow Creek District at the Moonsprings vines clinging to their steep hillsides. Not only is this undoubtedly one of the most beautiful sites we source fruit from, nestled in the Templeton Gap, it is also one of the coolest. While tasting barrels we were continually drawn to the effortless grace of the Syrah from Moonsprings and decided to recognize this unique sense of place with a small vineyard designate bottling. We are excited to make the introductions and we hope you enjoy.
