Winemaking

Unique to our lineup of wines, Tsundere leans heavily on Bordeaux Varieties with Cabernet Sauvignon at its core providing deep cola and red fruits, herbal undertones and dense tannin structure. Petit Verdot and Merlot complement the blend adding layers of Violet, black fruits, and spice box notes. Syrah brings it all together with blue fruits, savory accents and chalkier tannins filling out the middle third of the palate. The resulting wine is remarkably complex and a joy to experience as it opens with time in the cellar or even in the glass over the course of an evening. For the 2023 vintage, each of the varieties were fermented separately utilizing native yeast and primarily punch downs with a single aeration on the Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot. Following a gentle basket pressing, the wines were aged on lees for 22 months in nearly 80% New French Oak 300L barrels with the remaining 20% once used. The wine is then bottled unfined and unfiltered and aged an additional 12 months in bottle prior to our fall 2026 release. While it will age beautifully in the cellar for 10-15 years, Tsundere can be experienced in its youth by opening ahead of time or decanting.
